RMD NETWORKS LAUNCHES PQRI REPORTING SERVICE

Service allows RMD users to more easily qualify for enhanced Medicare reimbursements

DENVER, December 1, 2009—RMD Networks, Inc. today launched its new PQRI Reporting Service for physicians who utilize RMD's clinical groupware platform, and who see Medicare Part B patients. Use of the new Service allows these physicians to more easily qualify for incentive payments available to those who can demonstrate compliance with certain Medicare quality initiatives.

PQRI, the Physician Quality Reporting Initiative, is provided by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Service (CMS), the government entity responsible for the Medicare program, including reimbursements to physicians. For the 2009 reporting year, RMD Networks is a certified reporting provider. Users of the RMD Platform can utilize the Service, and leverage patient data and information entered into RMD's clinical registry, to help meet PQRI program requirements from any of ten (10) quality measures covering diabetes and preventative care and screening.

To use the service, a physician must see Medicare Part B Fee-for-Service (FFS) patients; must be a user of the RMD Platform; and must use RMD's CareSpace clinical registry. Several thousand physicians are eligible to use the Reporting Service. Those that do, and who comply with PQRI program requirements (as determined by CMS) are eligible to earn an additional 2% of their total allowed annual charges. The incentives are designed to improve the quality of care provided to Medicare patients.

This is the first reporting year for which RMD Networks has offered the Reporting Service. The company expects to continue offering the Service annually.
